QAI MISSION STATEMENT

To promote, protect and defend, through systems advocacy, the fundamental needs and rights and lives of the most vulnerable people with disability in Queensland

EXTRACT FROM THE QAI CONSTITUTION – ARTICLE #3 OBJECTS

The objects for which the Association is established are-

- (a) To affirm and put first people with disability in Queensland
- (b) To do systems advocacy that strives to promote, protect and defend the fundamental needs and rights and lives of the most vulnerable people with disability in Queensland
- (c) To do legal advocacy that strives to promote, protect and defend the fundamental needs and rights and lives of the most vulnerable people with disability in Queensland
- (d) To take an active leadership role in advocating for the fundamental needs and rights and lives of the most vulnerable people with disability in Queensland
- (e) To support, promote and protect the development of advocacy initiatives for the most vulnerable people with disability in Queensland
- (f) To be accountable to the most vulnerable people with disability in Queensland
- (g) To conduct an efficient and accountable organisation
- (h) To adhere to and constantly reaffirm the following beliefs and principles-
 - All human life has intrinsic dignity and worth
 - People with disability must positively and actively be accorded worth, dignity, meaning and purpose through being included in and with their community
 - Social Advocacy is functioning (speaking, acting, writing) with minimum conflict of interest on behalf of the sincerely perceived interests of a person or group, in order to promote, protect and defend the welfare of, and justice for, either individuals or groups, in a fashion which strives to be emphatic and vigorous, and/or which is actually, or very likely to be, "costly" to the actor, egg in terms of-
 - · time or other resources
 - emotional stress
 - bodily demands
 - social opprobrium, rejection, ridicule
 - self-esteem, self-certainty
 - socio-economic security, livelihood
 - physical safety, life
 - and the essential elements of Social Advocacy are
 - strict impartiality
 - minimal conflict of interest
 - emphasis on fundamental needs and issues
 - vigorous action
 - cost to the advocate
 - fidelity
 - being mindful of the most vulnerable person
 - Systems advocacy is a particular advocacy form that focuses on influencing and changing 'the system' (as in the whole of society and the various systems operating within) in ways that will benefit people with disability as a group within society. Systems advocacy includes, but is not limited to, policy and law reform activities.
